For Your Safety: Dial *57

QUESTION:

"It is possible to trace a call?"

We have had several calls lately from people wanting to know about our call trace service. Every phone in our systems has call trace capability. This is how it works. If you receive an abusive or threatening

call that you feel needs to be reported to law enforcement, dial *57 before receiving any other calls and your last incoming call detail will be saved in our switch. Call the local police or the sheriff's office and place a complaint. They will call us and we will reveal the number of that call to them. 368-6391 At no time will we give that information to anyone else. This is no charge for this service.
